Our Care Services Team



Attendance Monitoring

Our Care Services Team monitors your Caregiver's attendance to your visit. You can have peace of mind knowing that we monitor whether your Caregiver has arrived on time, or will keep you updated if they are running late.







Loneliness and isolation are among the leading causes of depression. Nurse Next Door understands that you may need help with certain activities, or a friend along the way. Our trusted Caregivers are specifically chosen to provide and support social interaction for maintaining health and mental well-being. It's all about happiness!

Our Companionship services include activities such as:

- Social activities at home or in the community

- Conversation, storytelling and reading books

If around-the-clock care is needed, Nurse Next Door offers 24/7 Care services. This is a great option for clients who require ongoing services throughout the day and night. Depending on your needs, a range of services can be scheduled daily, weekly, or monthly.

24/7 Care services can include:

- Companionship
- Homemaking
- Personal care
- Medication management
- Dementia care



Allied Health Support

Nurse Next Door understand that in some cases there may be a number of other allied health professionals involved in your care.

Our team can work collaboratively with:

- Podiatrists
- Dietitians
- Physiotherapists
- Psychologists etc.



Some days, handling day-to-day tasks on your own can feel like quite a challenge. Whether it's bathing or shaving, Nurse Next Door can assist with your ADL's (Activities of Daily Living). Our goal is to assist clients to maintain an independent lifestyle wherever they live at home, in assisted living or even in a long-term care facility.

Personal Care services may include:

- Bathing and personal hygiene
- Personal grooming and getting dressed
- Hair and skin care
- Oral hygiene (brushing, flossing, denture care)
- Toileting assistance
- Ambulation assistance and transfers with or without mechanical aids



Medication Management

Taking medication on time is essential for several reasons, adhering to prescribed medication schedules ensures that the medication achieves its intended therapeutic effects. Consistent medication use can help control symptoms, prevent disease progression, and improve overall health outcomes.

Our Caregivers and Nurses can provide you with the support you need to manage your medication. In some cases this may just be medication prompting, assisting with medication and medication administration. Your Care Designer will work with you to determine the level of support you require.



Transportation or Accompaniment

Being able to go to and from daily activities is a large part of maintaining your sense of independence and lifestyle. We can arrange for a Nurse Next Door Caregiver to provide transportation and/or accompaniment.

Our Caregivers may provide this service for:

- Appointments
 - Physical activities
- Shopping
- Religious services
- Groceries
- Family events



At Nurse Next Door, our Palliative Care is supportive and compassionate. It focuses on comfort, quality of life, and support for families. We will respect your personal health care treatment decisions. Care can be provided where you are living: whether this is at home, in hospice, an assisted living residence or a residential care facility.

Our services can include:

- Assistance with personal care such as bathing or medication management
- Respite Care so family caregivers can rest



Nursing Care

Nursing Care is an integral part of Nurse Next Door's services. We define Nursing Care as a "dynamic, caring relationship in which the Nurse assists the client to achieve and maintain optimal health." Our Nursing Team consists of Registered Nurses (RN) and Enrolled Nurses (EN) to meet your personal nursing needs.

Our Nursing team can assist with the following for clients in the acute, rehabilitative or chronic stages of their illness:

- Assessment and care planning
- Administering medication
- Pain and symptom management
- Intravenous therapy
- Wound care management changing dressings
- Management of enteral feedings
- Procedures (eg. catheter insertions, tracheostomy care)
- Client health education
- Wellness checks
- Post-surgical care



Caregiver Relief/Respite Care

Caring for a loved one can be demanding.

Nurse Next Door provides Respite Care for families who need temporary relief: you may need to attend to other responsibilities or a chance to simply recharge. Being rested and present allows you to be able to enjoy more fulfilling and meaningful time with your loved ones.



Alzheimer's and Dementia Support

Nurse Next Door understands that when a loved one has been diagnosed with Alzheimer's or another form of dementia, it can be a very challenging time.

We provide support and guidance to clients and their families in dealing with ongoing challenges and other caring responsibilities.

Our services include:

- Providing techniques to improve communication
- Coping strategies for family caregivers to deal with challenging behavior
- Maintaining a familiar and safe environment with a daily routine
- Memory games and activities for mental stimulation
- Family support through resources, training, educating and Respite Care
- Promoting a physical activity plan



At Nurse Next Door, we offer light housekeeping services for our clients to assist them with daily activities, so our clients can remain at home in a safe and clean environment.

Our Homemaking services include:

- Laundry
- Tidying up
- Washing dishesDusting
- Vacuuming
- Bedmaking



Meal Preparation

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Frequently Asked Questions

Are your services only for older people?

No - we provide services to all ages. We also provide services to people living with a disability.

Can I use my Government Funded Home Care Package or National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) funding to pay for my services?

Nurse Next Door works with NDIS participants and clients with Government Funded Aged Care Packages regularly and, in most cases, you will be able to use your funding to pay for services. Speak to one of our team to clarify the funding options.

Do you provide services in long-term care facilities or assisted living facilities?

Yes, people sometimes discover that the assistance provided in a facility is not enough so we can provide services to you or your loved one in facilities such as hospitals, long-term care, assisted living facilities and retirement communities.

How does the cost of staying in my home compare to living in an assisted living care facility?

Depending on needs, the costs associated with home care services can be comparable or less than the costs of a nursing home.

How is a Caregiver or Nurse selected for a visit?

Once our Care Designer completes your Caring Consult, they will select the most suitable Caregivers based on your needs and personality. We always keep you updated on the schedule so you are aware of which Caregivers will be coming.

Will I have the same Caregiver or Nurse all the time?

Nurse Next Door will pair you up with Caregivers and Nurses based on skills, personality and interests — providing a consistent team in order to build trusting and caring relationships with familiar faces who know your personal care routine.

What happens if my Caregiver or Nurse is not available?

If your primary Caregiver or Nurse is ill, another member on your Care Team will be there for you. At Nurse Next Door we aim to build a Care Team, overseen by your Care Designer, so that you will always have a familiar, friendly face.

Can I change the schedule if I have appointments to keep?

We understand that there may be times when you need to change your schedule due to outside appointments or family commitments. Nurse Next Door makes the schedule work for you and your family — your needs and requests come first and we will do our best to accommodate them. When you anticipate having to reschedule, please contact our Care Services Team to add, change, or cancel a visit. We ask that you give us as much notice as possible, preferably 24 hours.

Do I have to sign a contract for services and am I committed for a specified period of time?

After your Caring Consult, your Care Designer will suggest the type and frequency of services based on your needs. To start care, you will need to sign a Client Service Agreement which your Care Designer will review with you & your family. There are no lock in contracts so when you no longer need our services, we simply require a minimum of 24 hours notice to cancel services. (Please Note that NDIS participants are subject to the Government Cancellation Guidelines)

What if I need to speak to someone outside of business hours?

Our Care Services Team is available 24/7. You can call at any time and one of our Specialists will be happy to assist you.

How is the Care Plan created and can it be modified?

Ideally, you and your family will participate fully in the planning of your care. Sometimes information is obtained through discussion with your family doctor, hospital staff, or other health professionals. Your Care Designer will create your Care Plan by identifying specific goals that are responsive, flexible and in line with your care needs. A copy of the Care Plan will be available to you. The Caregiver or Nurse will follow the Care Plan and notify your Care Designer if there are any changes. Your Care Designer will conduct regular visits to your home to ensure that you are satisfied and the care provided is meeting your needs.

Encouraging Your Loved One To Accept Help

Deciding what's best for you, or your loved one, is not an easy decision. If you are looking for care, it may require a conversation with your loved one, another relative, the family doctor, or other allied health providers.

While it may seem like a big decision, introducing a Caregiver or Nurse into your loved one's life is often an easy, seamless transition.



Seek the advice of a trusted professional.

Your family General Practitioner (GP) can be your best ally in getting your parents or family member to accept help.



Give them an out.

"Let's try this for two months. If you still don't like having someone help you with the chores, then we can consider other options."



Hire a Caregiver to manage household chores and not actual hands on care.

Place emphasis on just getting help around the house like vacuuming, laundry, grocery shopping or meal preparation.



If there are two people involved, place your attention on the person who needs less help.

By allying yourself with the more independent individual, you may ultimately be able to get them both to accept the help they require.



Focus on you as the family caregiver needing the help, not them needing assistance.

Example: "I'm having trouble sleeping because I'm worried about you. Please help me come up with a solution that we can both live with."



Tour a few nursing homes as an alternative.

Let them choose whether they want to move out or stay at home. If they want to stay at home for as long as possible (or forever!), then hiring a Caregiver is the first step.



Discuss money.

Let them know that spending money on their happiness and keeping them in their own home is worth far more to you than a few extra dollars of inheritance money.



Show them the statistics.

Almost all injury-related hospitalisations are the result of a simple fall. One out of every three older Australians will fall this year. By having a little bit of help, you can help minimise these accidents.



Ask them about their fears of accepting external help.

Studies show the #1 fear of ageing is losing independence. Nurse Next Door believes in autonomy for all our clients clients will not lose their freedom to make life decisions for themselves.



If all else fails, introduce the Caregiver as a friend or companion.

A friend is trustworthy and can provide companionship.
